Meeting with the "shadows", Mr Streļčenoks welcomed young people's choice to shadow KNAB and to get answers to their questions about the KNAB work.

At the end of the day, young people acknowledged that they do not regret their choice to go to Riga and to become acquainted with the KNAB work. It was surprise for them that KNAB work is so multiform, because coming here they did not know that "KNAB is working not only in terms of political monitoring action, but also is performing prevention of the corruption risks and educational work, as well as performs control of the actions of government officials and financial control of the political parties".

This is a third year, when KNAB takes part in the "Shadows day" and gives opportunity to a young people, who are interested in the work of the institution and fight against corruption, to get insight in behind of the scenes of KNAB daily work.
